1. Message from WKO President

Please reconfirm that WKO shares an equal partnership with KWU (Kyokushin World Union), for the common goal of promoting the inclusion of Kyokushin Karate/Full Contact Karate in the Olympic Games. ④. Invitation of Japanese Instructors

The WKO office receives numerous invitations for Japanese instructors every year. Standard procedure calls for the Official Invitation Letter to be sent to the WKO Office with the necessary information filled in. The invitation becomes official only when the letter arrives at the WKO Office. Please refrain from direct negotiations with Japanese instructors, for it will only lead to problems in the future. Finally, we would like for all to understand that an agreement based on direct negotiations will not be considered an official invitation.

⑤. Acceptance of Students from Overseas Branches

Every year, numerous students from overseas branches visit Japan for the purpose of training. When a student wishes to visit Japan for training, standard procedure calls for the Branch Chief or Contact (who the student belongs to) to contact the WKO Office of the ideal time frame, dojo, and detailed information (name, dan/kyu, age, etc.) of the student. The WKO Office will confirm the content of the request with the Branch Chief/Contact of the dojo in Japan. In a case where an overseas student goes forth with his/her training in Japan without consulting the WKO Office, it would delay the response time of the WKO Office if an emergency happened to occur. To assure the safety of the students, we ask for everyone's cooperation in this matter.

⑥. Centralization of communication between Overseas Branches

It is required that communication (related to events within the organization) between Overseas Branches and Japanese Branch Chiefs & Contacts be exchanged through the WKO Office. Translation of documents (Japanese⇔English) will also be managed by the WKO Office. In order to avoid any unnecessary problems and confusion, we ask for everyone's cooperation in the centralization of communication between overseas branches.

Official relationship means invitations and/or participations to tournaments, seminars, camps and other official events. The above mentioned organization/dojos are those who have been separated from us since the passing away of Sosai Oyama. Regarding cooperation within each country, it is up to the domestic and regional organizations to regulate this matter themselves.

2. Introduction and Jurisdiction

2.1 This is the final Decision of the WKO Disciplinary Panel as between World Karate Organization and Mr. Eltac Humbatov relating to an Anti-Doping Rule Violation ("ADRV") arising from the World Karate Organization Anti-Doping Rules ("the ADR").

2.2 The World Karate Organization is the governing body for the sport of Karate.

2.3 The *Athlete* is a 23 year-old competitor in Karate, representing Azerbaijan. At all material times, he was subject to the jurisdiction of WKO and bound to comply with the ADR. Pursuant to the ADR, Polish Anti-Doping Agency was empowered to conduct *Doping Control*, as those terms are used in the ADR, in respect of all *Athletes* subject to the jurisdiction of the European Karate Organization.



3. Background and charges

3.1 Mr Eltac Humbatoff took part in the European Karate Organization Under 21 year Youth Karate Championship In Kielce the 11th. November 2017. Mr. Humbatoff participated in the division U21 and won his category. At the championship all first places was selected to be tested by the Polish Anti Doping Agency. The samples were send to the laboratory of Department of Anti-Doping Research Institute of Sport - National Research Institute Trylogii 2/16^[L1]_[SEP]Warsaw^[L1]_[SEP]POLAND 01-98

3.2 Analyzed by the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA)-accredited Laboratory: Department of Anti-Doping Research Institute of Sport - National Research Institute Trylogii 2/16^[L1]_[SEP]Warsaw^[L1]_[SEP]

3.3 Substances identified in the *Sample* number: 6274682^[L1]_[SEP]

S1.1A Exogenous AAS/methasterone and its metabolite 2 α ,17 α -dimethyl-5 α -androstan-3 α ,17 β -diol

3.4 *Adverse Analytical Finding* ("AAF") reviewed, and no departures from the International Standards for Laboratories or International Standards for Testing and Investigations were identified. The *Athlete* does not hold a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE).

3.5 Notification of charge to the *Athlete* on 26. October 2018 according to Article 2.1. The athlete immediately respond that he understood the charges and informed that he want to corporate and ask for his case to be finished as fast as possible.

4. Procedural issues and plea

Procedural steps and choices made by the *Athlete* with regard to procedure:

4.1 Mr. Humbatoff accepted the charge and admitted the violation of the WADA protocol article 2.21 and understood the AAF report which shows that his Sample A included substance Methasterone. **Methasterone is included in the group S1 - Anabolic Agents and it is prohibited in sport**

As described In the report:

- S1.1A Exogenous AAS/methasterone and its metabolite 2 α ,17 α -dimethyl-5 α -androstan-3 α ,17 β -diol.

Details concerning Finding:

Methasterone (17 β -hydroxy-2 α ,17 α -dimethyl-5 α -androstan-3-one) and its metabolite: 2 α ,17 α -dimethyl-5 α - androstan-3 α ,17 β -diol.



4.2 Request/Waiver of B *Sample Testing*

4.3 To make sure Mr. Humbatoff understood the charge and his situation regarding the AAF he was contacted and asked to have a meeting via Mobile, Skype or other suitable media so that he could explain he understood and if he want to have a Hearing face to face. It was agreed to have such a meeting via the Video media Whatsapp the 4th. January 2019. During this conversation Mr. Humbatoff explained that he waive from further in person hearing, that he do not need a lawyer, that he can get assistance from Azerbaijan Shinkyokushin Karate Organization and to have his sample B tested. He also confirmed he got the same information by letter and that he just wanted to have the case closed so he can come back and participate in Karate tournaments

5. Evidence

5.1.1 Anti Doping Test taken the 11th November 2017 by the Polish Anti Doping Agency and analysed by Department of Anti-Doping Research Institute of Sport - National Research Institute Trylogii 2/16^[1]Warsaw^[1]POLAND 01-98

5.1.2 The Doping Control form that indicates AAF - Adverse Analytical Finding

5.1.3 The A *Sample* reports, indicating - S1.1A Exogenous AAS/methasterone and its metabolite 2 α ,17 α -dimethyl-5 α -androstan-3 α ,17 β -diol.

5.2 The evidence presented by the *Athlete* was as follows: Copy of the AFF report from ADAMS.

6. Assessment of evidence

(In this section the report may need to comment on the **reliability** of the *Testing* process / results and the **probability** of the *Athlete's* version.)

7. Finding

The presence of the substances identified as **Methasterone** was established by the A *Sample* reports, which were not contested by the *Athlete*. The **LH concentration: 52.8 mIU/mL^[1]** is above the physiological level. Methasterone is a potent oral anabolic steroid. Methasterone is a modified form of dihydrotestosterone. It differs by: 1) the addition of a methyl group at carbon 17-alpha, which helps protect the hormone during oral administration, and 2) the introduction of a methyl group at carbon-2 (alpha), which considerably increases the anabolic strength of the steroid



by heightening its resistance to metabolism by the 3-hydroxysteroid dehydrogenase enzyme in skeletal muscle tissue. Anabolic-androgenic steroids (AAS) are synthetically produced versions of the naturally occurring male sex hormone testosterone. The term "anabolic" refers to muscle-building whilst "androgenic" refers to increased male sexual characteristics; "steroids" refer to the class of

When confronted about the case regards the ADRV the explanation of Mr. Humbatoff for the presence of the substances, was he was deeply disappointed about the letter sent by AKKF which explained he was under investigation about validating the WADA protocol. Mr Humbatoff also say that he do respect the law by WKO and EKO. Mr. Eltac Humbatoff also thought the substance he took, called Modern BCAA, and complies with the WADA Antidoping list.

Mr Humbatoff explained that he bought the BCAA two month before the EC in Kielce and took the substance about 3 – 4 times every week,

The Hearing Panel believes that this explanation is unreasonable because normal Sport Protein Powder as normal nutrition most likely does not hold Methasterone.

For the reasons outlined above the Committee has determined that the *Athlete* is guilty of the offences outlined in the charges and is in violation of Article 2.21 in the WADA protocol

8. Evidence and argument on Sanction

8.1 Mr. Humbatov apologized for the presence of the ADRV and explained he is not sure how the substance was found in the test.

8.2 Reasons for elimination/reduction of period of *Ineligibility*

There is no reason not to use the standard sanction time of two years. But Mr. Humbatov was already in May 2018 informed unofficially about the finding. From that time Mr. Humbatov refrained to take part in any Karate tournament Karate activities by his own decision. Not until 26. October 2018 he was suspended by the Azerbaijan Shinkyokushin Karate Organization which the Hearing panel find as a fail from the National Federation which should not be of an extra sanction period

8.3 Impact of Sanction

Mr. Humbatov will not be able to participate in any tournament as such for a period of two years from 1. June 2018. All eventually that date and trophies and medals cancel results from any sports competition, money what so ever must be handed returned to the event organizers.

9. Right to appeal

Decisions of the WKO Disciplinary Panel may be appealed By Mr. Humbatoff, Azerbaijan Shinkyokushin Karate Federation, European Karate Organisation and World Karate Organization as provided in Article 17.1.1 of the WKO Anti Doping Rules.



10. Decision on Sanction

10.1 *Ineligibility*

The Ineligibility starts the date of 1. June 2018 lasting until 31. May 2020

10.1.1 "During the period of *Ineligibility*, in accordance with WKO Anti Doping Rule the *Athlete* shall not be permitted to participate in any capacity in a *Competition* or other activity (other than authorized anti-doping education or rehabilitation programs) organized, convened or authorized by: 10.1.1.1 the Azerbaijan Shinkyokushin Karate Federation or by any body that is a member of, or affiliated to, or licensed by the World Karate Organization and:

10.1.1.2 any *Signatory* (as that term is defined in the ADR);

10.1.1.3 any club or other body that is a member of, or affiliated to, or licensed by, a *Signatory* or a *Signatory's* member organization; or

10.1.1.4 any professional league or any International- or national-level *Event* organization.

10.1.2 Start date of *Ineligibility* 1st. June 2018

10.2 Disqualification of Results

10.2.1 Pursuant to the WKO Anti Doping Rule any individual results obtained by the *Athlete* since the date of the violation are hereby disqualified, with all resulting *Consequences*, including forfeiture of any medals, titles, points and prizes.
