### ④. Invitation of Japanese Instructors

The WKO office receives numerous invitations for Japanese instructors every year. Standard procedure calls for the Official Invitation Letter to be sent to the WKO Office with the necessary information filled in. The invitation becomes official only when the letter arrives at the WKO

Office. Please refrain from direct negotiations with Japanese instructors, for it will only lead to problems in the future. Finally, we would like for all to understand that an agreement based on direct negotiations will not be considered an official invitation.

### ⑤. Acceptance of Students from Overseas Branches

Every year, numerous students from overseas branches visit Japan for the purpose of training. When a student wishes to visit Japan for training, standard procedure calls for the Branch Chief or Contact (who the student belongs to) to contact the WKO Office of the ideal time frame, dojo, and detailed information (name, dan/kyu, age, etc.) of the student. The WKO Office will confirm the content of the request with the Branch Chief/Contact of the dojo in Japan. In a case where an overseas student goes forth with his/her training in Japan without consulting the WKO Office, it would delay the response time of the WKO Office if an emergency happened to occur. To assure the safety of the students, we ask for everyone's cooperation in this matter.

### ⑥. Centralization of communication between Overseas Branches

It is required that communication (related to events within the organization) between Overseas Branches and Japanese Branch Chiefs & Contacts be exchanged through the WKO Office. Translation of documents (Japanese⇔English) will also be managed by the WKO Office. In order to avoid any unnecessary problems and confusion, we ask for everyone's cooperation in the centralization of communication between overseas branches.

WKO General Financial Situation for Fiscal Year 2017 (1 April 2017–31 March 2018)

Yasukazu Koi, WKO Executive Director

In the Karate world, the international united front of Full Contact Karate is expanding at a steady pace, while the WKF carries out activities in preparation for the Tokyo 2020 Olympics. The current trend within the Full Contact Karate world, of division and reduction within other Kyokushin groups, and the experiment of the semi-contact competition, can be seen as external elements that will lead to an increase in the presence of WKO. By playing the leading role in the organizing of the World Fullcontact Karate Championship in 2020, and the establishment of the WFKO (World Fullcontact Karate Organization), the international federation (IF) for Full Contact Karate, the international presence of WKO as the leader of the Full Contact Karate world will increase even further. In the trend to establish national federations (NF) of Full Contact Karate, and the promotion of exchange between KWU, which WKO enjoys a partnership with, it is important for WKO affiliated countries and branches to carry out their activities with a clear vision of collective interest, in order to increase the importance, uniqueness, and value of WKO as an organization.

In this fiscal year, the profit base is stable due to the weak yen and increase in affiliated countries and members, but it is also clear that the profit from the Japan Region is still the main pillar for the entire organization. Compared to the previous fiscal year, there was a significant increase in the Dan grading fees, and this is related to the fact that the WKO Grading Exam was held twice. On the other hand, in terms of expenses, various costs were involved with the World Championship in Weight Categories, such as financial support for the organizer, office-related expenses (transportation, interpreter, etc.), and public relations (production of online program). In general, the profit margin decreased from the previous year, but the organization was able to secure an ordinary profit of 3 million yen, making it a good fiscal year.

**■ Net Sales: ¥ 44,700,000 【Previous Period ¥40,000,000 (+¥4,700,000)】**

The flat trend in the exchange rate and number of worldwide members, need to be taken into account when analyzing this section. There was a significant increase of 5 million yen in the Dan grading fees compared to the previous period. This is mainly related to the WKO Grading Exam being held twice, but the numbers for various regions increased as well. Such main factors led to a 10% increase in net sales, which amounted to ¥45 million yen. Although the arrangements for the accounting standards (a shift to accrual basis) are gradually improving, the cooperation of all countries and branches is necessary for completion. The Yen rate at the end of March 2018 was 1 US Dollar = 106 yen (previous period 112 yen).

**■ Gross Profit on Sales: ¥ 39,200,000 【Previous Period ¥35,200,000 (+¥4,000,000)】**

The increase in purchase (belts) corresponds to the increase in Dan promotions. The cost of sales is based on Yen, and does not have any significant effect from the exchange rate. The increase in Dan promotions was directly reflected in the result.

■ **Sales, General & Administration Expenses: ¥35,900,000 【Previous Period ¥26,400,000 (+9,500,000)】**

In general, the expenses related to the World Karate Championship in Weight Categories, is the main reason behind the difference from the previous period. The traveling transportation expense is mainly comprised of the costs related to the World Karate Championship in Weight Categories (WKO Office staff), and the KWU World Championship (WKO official, PR, etc.). For the commission paid, there was a significant increase (8 million yen) in the expenses related to the World Karate Championship in Weight Categories. The financial support towards the organizer, interpreter/translator costs, and the production of the online program were the main reasons behind this increase. The costs for the translating staff (English, Russian, social media) of the WKO Office have been included from this fiscal year (JKO covered such costs in past fiscal years). As was the case in the previous period, the payment of 2.4 million yen to the Oyama family for the use of the “Masutatsu Oyama trademark” is also included in the expenses. The above factors contributed to a 36% increase (compared to previous year) for a total of 35.9 million yen.

■ **Ordinary Profit: ¥3,100,000 【Previous Period ¥8,500,000 (-¥5,500,000)】**

Non-operating expenses include the interest payable for borrowings (from JKO). In total, the increase in the gross profit on sales was able to cover the increase in the sales, general & administration expenses related to the World Karate Championship in Weight Categories. Due to such factors, WKO was able to secure an ordinary profit of 3.1 million yen (decrease of 5.5 million yen compared to previous period).

## WKO Auditor Report for Fiscal Year 2017

Based on our auditing of the administrative and accounting procedures of WKO during 2017 April 1<sup>st</sup> to 2018 March 31<sup>st</sup>, we would like to report as follows.

### 【1】 Auditor Comments

The profit base of the organization is stable due to the weak yen and increase in affiliated countries and members. The profit from Japan is still the main pillar of the entire organization, but due to the steady increase of members in Asia and other factors, there seems to be hope a change in such trend. As a goal, if the affiliated countries can achieve significant growth, ideally to a level similar to Poland, which has 7,000 to 8,000 members, it would enable the organization to carry out activities in a more stable manner.

In terms of profit, there was a significant increase in the Dan grading fees, due to the WKO Grading Exam being held twice. For the expenses, significant costs were necessary for the World Karate Championship in Weight Categories, such as financial support for the organizer, office-related expenses, public relations, and other matters.

In addition, for the reimbursement by the Russian Branch Chief that has remained to be an issue, efforts have been made to receive a reimbursement plan, and payments are being made to settle the case.

In general, the profit margin decreased from the previous year, but the organization was able to secure an ordinary profit of 3 million, making it a good fiscal year.

In terms of auditing, the equipment and documents in the office were organized in a neat manner, and enabled a smooth auditing procedure.

### 【2】 Auditor Report

#### ( 1 ) Outline of Audit Procedure

- ① For the auditing of accounting procedures, we considered the accuracy of the accounting documents utilizing all necessary measures, including the viewing of account books and related papers.
- ② For the auditing of administrative procedures, we attended meetings such as the Board Meeting and General Assembly, listened to administrative reports, and utilized all necessary measures to consider the appropriateness of the executed work.

#### ( 2 ) Result of Auditing

As a result of the above auditing, the accounting process was appropriate and precise. The administrative work was also properly executed based on the business plan.




