1. Message from WKO President

I also feel empowered by young children who have just started to train in Karate in spring, coming to Dojo with their white belts on, learning Sanchin-Dachi, Seiken-Zuki, and meditating in Seiza. We get stronger and kinder through Full-contact Karate. My wish for them is to become a Budoka, who makes friends all over the world and creates a society full of smiles. Today, the energetic voice of children's Kiai echoes in Dojos around the world. Let us be the trustworthy Karateka, who pursue the deep and profound world of Budo, to be energetic as the young new powers.

We WKO are less than four months away from the 13th World Championship. Many of the competitors from each country and region have been selected. We have set the deadline for application to the end of June for Kumite, and the end of July for Kata. I feel my heart pounding, as the time to decide the World's Strongest Karateka is getting closer. I hope every competitor prepares themselves for the day, having the firm determination to "train hardest in the world," in both quantity and quality. This will influence the others who train together, and motivate them to train harder and aim higher.

Please join forces with your fellows, and bring various strengths together to prepare for the play-off.

In Japan, the 8th JFKO Championship was held on the 20th and 21st of May, and powerful fighters from 360 different Karate Organizations gathered to decide the strongest.

It has been 10 years since the founding of the Japan Full-contact Karate Organization, the organizer of the championship. The years have been extremely fruitful for the leading country of the worldwide Full-contact Karate movement. In the championship, fighters from WKO achieved

remarkable results; six out of ten 1st places and 21 medals out of 40 were won by our fighters. From the result, the Japan National Team Members have been decided.

Now, it has been one year and four months since the situation in Ukraine began in February 2022. During the time, we held the World Championship in Weight Categories last September in Poland, the neighboring country to Ukraine. Even though it is ideal to separate sports and politics, we, WKO have decided to continue to take measures to require Russia and Belarus to refrain from participating in the international tournaments considering the reality of the war situation. This is thought to be the time of patience for the entire WKO community, hoping for the earliest ending of the war. Above all, the reality is that the Ukrainians are living in fear, not in a situation where they can train. I understand that it is also a hard time for Russian and Belarusian Karatekas not to be able to participate in international tournaments. Let us spend the patience together and pray for peace.

I sincerely wish to see the faces of all Shinkyokushin family members in the world, train and laugh together. I hope for the day to come soon.

For now, let us do the best we can through Full-contact Karate, in the place where we are placed.

Lastly, the preparations for the World Championship are steadily proceeding in our Headquarters. Various information is being gathered, and all the members in the Headquarters are determined to do their best to ensure all the visitors have the greatest moment and fully enjoy their stay in Japan. I hope for many comrades as possible to come and see the World Championships. I would like our best competitors to fight in the most exciting atmosphere. A fully crowded gymnasium, filled with thunderous cheers. The World Championship is just a few months away. Let's come together and create the ultimate moment of joy.

④. Invitation of Japanese Instructors

The WKO office receives numerous invitations for Japanese instructors every year. Standard procedure calls for the Official Invitation Letter to be sent to the WKO Office with the necessary information filled in. The invitation becomes official only when the letter arrives at the WKO Office. Please refrain from direct negotiations with Japanese instructors, for it will only lead to problems in the future. Finally, we would like for all to understand that an agreement based on direct negotiations will not be considered an official invitation.

⑤. Acceptance of Students from Overseas Branches

Every year, numerous students from overseas branches visit Japan for the purpose of training. When a student wishes to visit Japan for training, standard procedure calls for the Branch Chief or Contact (who the student belongs to) to contact the WKO Office of the ideal time frame, dojo, and detailed information (name, dan/kyu, age, etc.) of the student. The WKO Office will confirm the content of the request with the Branch Chief/Contact of the dojo in Japan. In a case where an overseas student goes forth with his/her training in Japan without consulting the WKO Office, it would delay the response time of the WKO Office if an emergency happened to occur. To assure the safety of the students, we ask for everyone’s cooperation in this matter.

⑥. Centralization of communication between Overseas Branches

It is required that communication (related to events within the organization) between Overseas
